Our deepest sympathies are with the family of the student at this time. The student has family members who attend Robb Elementary and Central Mountain Middle School. This loss is sure to raise many emotions, concerns, and questions for our entire school, especially our students and staff.

Keystone Central has a Crisis Intervention Team made up of professionals who are trained to help with the needs of students, parents, and school personnel at difficult times such as this. Starting this afternoon from 12pm to 3pm, and Wednesday through Friday from 8am to 3pm there will be a team of school counselors, social workers and school psychologists at Robb Elementary and CMMS to support any student or staff member who may need assistance in coping with this tragic news.
